Dress Code

I. Students are expected to attend the college neatly dressed in uniforms keeping in mind with an approved etiquette.

II. Women shall attend the college wearing saris only

III. Men shall attend the college wearing properly ironed and tucked in-shirt and pants, belt, shoes with socks. Shirts should be buttoned properly.

IV. The dress code for physical and athletic games-for boys it is T-Shirts with canvas shoes and for girls, it is churidhar with duppattas with canvas shoes.

Disciplinary code

01. Students should bring their I.D cards every day. I.D cards should be produced anytime when demanded.
02. The usage of cell phones is prohibited inside the college campus.
03. No student of one class shall enter any other class under any pretext.

04. Absolute silence should be maintained while moving from classrooms to laboratory/library/auditorium and back.
05. Students should not sit on the parapet walls or in the steps and in staircase.
06. Students are forbidden from writing, scribbling, painting, on the walls, desks, etc.
07. Students found guilty of damaging, destroying, college property shall replace the same at their own cost.
08. Students must identify those who cause damage to the college property and report the same to the principal immediately.
09. Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the campus.
10. Students found using drugs or liquor will be dismissed.
11. Students should not participate in politics/communal/religious activities.
12. Students found guilty of using for the language or behaving rudely towards the staff members, will be expelled from the college.
13. Students are advised to read notices put on the notice board ignorance of any notice thus put up will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with it.
14. The students should strictly have driving license and helmet while coming to college by two wheelers.
15. In case, any criminal case is registered against a student by the law enforcing authorities. He/she should intimate the same within 24 hours to the principal, failing which he/she is liable for disciplinary action leading to expulsion.
16. Under Tamil Nadu education rules.
 - a) The principal is empowered to inflict the following punishments in the interest of students of the institution concerned.
 - (i) Fine
 - (ii) Suspension and
 - (iii) Expulsion
 - b) The power to take disciplinary action against a student is inherent with the principal
17. Students can meet the principal at anytime other than the class time.
18. Any students found violation any of the rules and regulations of the college or found disturbing the peace in the campus as well as off the campus, will be liable for suspension by the head of the institution. Who has the right to dismiss the student without any explanation.
19. Students should attend meetings as per instructions. Decency and discipline should be maintained in meetings and conferences.
20. Students are advised not to bring valuable things like ornaments, heavy cash, electronic gadgets etc. Management is not responsible for any theft of valuables of cash inside/outside the campus.
21. Admissions are made to the colleges on the clear understanding that those who are admitted will fully abide by the rules and regulations in force and those with which may be enforced or modified as and when required by the colleges/university/government authorities.
22. The student should adhere to the rules and regulations that may be from time to time.

PARTICIPATION OF SEMINARS /WORKSHOPS AND SYMPOSIA

The assessment under this head shall include evaluation of leadership role play as well as participation made in follow up discussions, initiative, and contribution of ideas, creative thinking and receptivity. The seminar, workshops and symposia will relate to the optional and elective subjects.

Library Rules

1. Perfect silence should be maintained in the Library.
2. College professors, Students and non-teaching staff can make use of our library.
3. Library will be kept open on all working days from 9.30 a.m to 4.30 p.m
4. Students while entering the library must keep their personal belongings outside.
5. Students should not enter the library wearing coats or improper dress.
6. Students are instructed to sign the register while entering the library.
7. Students will be allowed to borrow two books at a time for a period of one week.
8. Books may be renewed for a further period of 7 days. Provided no other student has applied for the same books.
9. Marking in books or writing in them is strictly prohibited. For any such act, double the cost of the book will be collected from the borrower of the book.
10. A book may be renewed for a second time provided no other application for the book is pending.
11. Reference books, magazines, journals and dailies should not be taken out of the library.
12. Books taken for studies must be returned to the library in time and on the date specified.
13. A fine of Rs. 1/- will be charged per day for late returning of books.
14. The books if lost must be replaced by buying the books. If it is not replaced depending on the book 5 times the price will be collected.
15. If the book is not in a good condition the matter must be brought to the notice of the Librarian at the time of the issue itself.
16. No member is allowed to take library books for others in or outside the college. If one does so, the person concerned will be punished by fine or suspension of membership of the Library.
17. The library will be closed on govt. Holiday and during the summer vacation.
18. Students who leave the college for any reason in the middle of the year should return the books before they leave the college, for obtaining No dues certificate from the librarian
19. Students can apply for library books in the prescribed requisition form
20. Students must return their books at the end of academic year and obtain a No dues certificate from the library.
21. Students will not be permitted inside the library during the class hours.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

1. Hostellers must occupy the rooms allotted to them and must not change their room without the permission of the Deputy Warden.
2. All the inmates should leave the hostel at least 15 minutes before the commencement of the classes.
3. No students are allowed to stay in the hostel during college hours without prior permission from the Deputy Warden.
4. Students can do their shopping with the permissions from the Deputy Warden.
5. Continuous absence without permission will result in expulsion.
6. Hostellers are expected to be in the hostel at 6.00 p.m. They can permit to go out after 6.00 p.m. with specific permission of the Deputy Warden.
7. The main gate of the hostel is closed at 6.00.p.m and will be opened at 6.00a.m next morning.
8. Hostellers falling sick should report to the Deputy Warden who will take necessary steps for treatment for minor injuries and ailments.
9. No vehicle can be kept in the hostel.
10. Hostellers can go home once in a month, with the approval of the Deputy Warden.
11. The inmates are accepted to vacate the room within a day after the institution closes for vacation or they are asked to do so for any reason.
12. Hostellers will be held responsible for the damage to the rooms they occupy any things like fan, furniture, tube light, switches, toilet, and sink etc. In case of damage or disfigurement of any or the hostel property, they have to pay the cost, as fixed by the Principal and Warden.
13. The period from 10.30PM to next day morning should be observed as silent hours. The students shall remain in their room.
14. Students are advised not to bring valuables to the hostel. The management will not be responsible for any loss that may be due to their negligence.
